How to Register to Vote

To register to vote, you must

- Be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Kansas
- Be at least age 18 before the next election.
- Have received final discharge from imprisonment, parole, or conditional release if convicted of a felony.
- Have abandoned your former residence and/or name.

Obtain an application from the County Clerk, 110 Courthouse Plaza, Manhattan, KS, 66502, or download a form from the Kansas Secretary of State web site: www.kssos.org. Fill out the form and return it to the County Clerk's office **at least 15 days prior to the election**. Form **must** be filled out completely.
